Scholarship Mission: Established January 14, 2007 to provide scholarship assistance to junior, senior, or graduate students majoring in a discipline within the University of Central Oklahoma's College of Fine Arts and Design.

Qualifications: The scholarship is open to any junior, senior, or graduate level student who exemplifies high academic standards by bearing an overall grade point average of at least 3.5. Candidates must possess a high level of artistry in their area of discipline and demonstrate leadership, personal achievement, integrity and character. Candidates must also be enrolled full-time (at least 12 credit hours undergraduate or 9 credit hours graduate).

Requirements: The recipient of this scholarship must maintain full-time enrollment (at least 12 credit hours undergraduate or 9 credit hours graduate) and maintain at least an overall 3.5 GPA to continue to receive the award for the spring semester. The recipient is required to write a brief essay about their artistic experience and performance activities for each semester the scholarship is awarded. Value and Duration: The Don Betz Leadership in the Arts Award is valued at \$500 (\$250 per semester) for one academic year. The scholarship monies may be used to assist with tuition, school fees, books, and on-campus room and board.

Qualifications: The scholarship is open to any undergraduate or graduate level student who exemplifies high academic standards by bearing an overall grade point average of at least 3.0. Candidates must possess a high level of artistry in their area of discipline and demonstrate leadership, personal achievement, integrity and character. Candidates must also be enrolled full-time (at least 12 credit hours undergraduate or 9 credit hours graduate).

Requirements: The recipient of this scholarship must maintain full-time enrollment (at least 12 credit hours undergraduate or 9 credit hours graduate) and maintain at least an overall 3.0 GPA to continue to receive the award for the spring semester. The recipient is required to write a brief essay about their artistic experience and performance activities for each semester the scholarship is awarded. Copies of the essay will be sent to donors and alumni and possibly be printed in donor related publications.

The Arts Abroad Scholarship

Scholarship Mission: To provide funds for any CFAD student who wishes to study the arts abroad.

Value and Duration: The Arts Abroad Scholarship is valued at \$1,500 and can be used to assist with any travel abroad expenses. Applications are due before August 31, 2010.

Qualifications: The scholarship is open to any undergraduate or graduate level student who exemplifies high academic standards by bearing an overall grade point average of at least 3.0.

Requirements: Candidates must be currently enrolled in a CFAD class or enrolled in a CFAD class for the following semester. This scholarship applies to any student who plans to study the arts abroad. The student must offer proof of that study through letter of intent from a professor and an arts abroad agenda.

Additional Application Components: You must write a brief essay about why travel abroad is important to your area of study and set up an interview.

Application Process: To apply for this scholarship write a brief essay about why travel abroad is important to your area of study, acquire a letter of intent from a professor and an arts abroad agenda, and then contact the Director of The Melton Art Reference Library, Suzanne Silvester, to set up an interview.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Scholarships are for students engaged in a communications related study track attending any institute of higher learning in the state of Oklahoma and maintaining a minimum GPA of 2.75 with at least 60 hours credit.
- Applications must be received by the Scholarship Committee no later than 5 p.m. Friday, September 24, 2010. Any applications received after this date will not be considered.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS

- Official college transcript
- Two sealed letters of recommendation from persons not related to you
- 200-word essay on the future of advertising
- Work samples. You are required to submit work samples based on your course of study or strength. That is, designers should provide design samples, public relations majors should provide PR related materials, advertising majors should provide graphics, media plans, marketing plans, etc. Submitted materials should be in DVD, CD, PDF, Word, or XLS format, where applicable. **SAMPLES WILL NOT BE RETURNED.**

INTERVIEW

- Finalists for the three (3) \$2,000 JAC awards will be selected by the committee and interviewed. The candidates deemed to possess the traits, communication skills and intellect best representing the highest standards of industry professionalism and ethics will earn the JAC Award.

AWARD SELECTION

- Applications are reviewed by the AAF Oklahoma City Ad Club Scholarship Committee
- Recipients are determined as those best meeting the criteria set forth by the Committee
- The Scholarship Committee uses the information received from applications and interviews to make such determinations• Awardees will be notified prior to and presented with their awards on career day on November 10, 2009. Payment will be in the form of a \$2,000 check made payable to the winners
